## Basic Plan



-The first day and a half will be a boot camp together - team building, worship, prayer and empowering talks.

-A day of orientation within a Zulu community learning about food, culture, history, life and struggles.

-Four days of work and service in different teams in various communities around Durban.

-Day off! (shopping, beach, safari, rest)

-Joint day of outreach together as a unified team.

-Three days of work and service.

-Debrief

**Ministry:** building, sports, leadership training, life skills training, unskilled work, family and kids camps, street kids programmes, reconciliation training, 24-7 prayer, discipleship training, and evangelism.

## Dates and Price



### Dates:

5th - 19th July, with the option of teams to stay longer.

### Price:

Airfare: Around £800 return - individuals and teams responsible for booking your own tickets.

Ground fees: we will not be in luxury but will have the basics. Around £15 a day per person. This would include room, board and transportation.

Additional expenses: Travel insurance, spending money, supplies...

VISA: If you are UK or Ireland born you will not need a VISA to get into South Africa.
